It's amazing how fast each year seems to come to an end. We are once again approaching the holiday season for 2025 where everyone will be busy enjoying family and friends.

The first round of Community Review has been completed and the Follow Up/Violation Reviews have started. You will see that we have changed our review notices a bit, moving things through the process a little faster. During this review, if the initial items from your courtesy letter have not been completed, your property will be considered in violation and given a final timeframe to complete.

Please be sure to contact us as soon as any items have been completed; whether from your initial Community Review Courtesy letter, or from the Follow Up/Violation notice. If the items have not been completed by the date in your Follow Up/Violation notice, you will be asked to a Formal Hearing with the Board of Directors. The Follow Up/Violation notices will be conducted throughout the fall into the winter, depending where your neighborhood falls in the review order. Please stay tuned to the weekly email blast for which neighborhood reviews are being conducted each week.

Remember, COMMUNICATION IS KEY. It is imperative for us to know if you have scheduled the work or if you need an extension. Please reach out to me anytime at sherrillekilncreek.com or call our office at 757-877-9835. We will follow up on all re-inspection requests as we are able, typically within one week of contacting us.

2026 BUDGET PROCESS UNDERWAY!



The Villages of Kiln Creek Owners Association | 31 Villages | Newport News & Yorktown, Virginia



The 2026 budget process is currently underway, and as always, community members are curious of any changes to the level of assessments. The Board determined a need to increase assessments nominally by 3.7% — slightly below the long-term inflation average — to keep up with rising costs in a fair and consistent way. (This will replace the previous 3.2% yearly increase.)





The final 2026 Operating Budget will be approved in mid-November, and the assessment level will be approved at the same time. With the anticipated 3.7% increase, this will bring your monthly assessments to \$118.98 per month, per lot, starting on January 1, 2026 (pending Board approval in November).





Once approved by the Board of Directors, the final budget will be posted on the members-only portion of the KCOA website at www.kilncreek.org/membersonly, and it will also be available at the KCOA Office for your review. Only after it has been posted online for 15 days will it be considered ratified. We will send details and reminders with all of this information in our Friday email blast and on our mobile app "News" in late November & December.



Please remember to adjust your monthly payment amount by January 1st. If you are on ACH, you should receive a notice from Truist in the mail and email of the updated amount. They will automatically adjust your payments for those on ACH per your agreement when you signed up. For anyone not on ACH with Truist, your coupon book will be mailed to you in mid-December.

YORK COUNTY **ANNOUNCES END OF CURBSIDE RECYCLING PROGRAM SEPTEMBER 30**









York County's curbside recycling program will officially conclude with the termination of the current contract on September 30, 2025. The County is actively exploring alternative solutions to continue offering curbside recycling services in the future. In the meantime, residents are asked to hold on to their recycling containers until further notice. Additional details and updates will be shared as soon as they are available. While curbside service is ending, recycling remains available to York County residents through the Recycling Convenience Center at York County Waste Management, located at 145 Goodwin Neck Road. (7 a.m. - 4 p.m., Monday through Saturday.) On a temporary basis, James City County will allow the residents of York County to utilize the following convenience centers for drop-off recycling: NOTE: Proper ID will be required. York County Residents may use any of the following drop-off centers free of charge:



- York County Waste Management Center, 145 Goodwin Neck Road Monday Saturday 7a.m. 4 p.m.)
- James City County's Jolly Pond Convenience Center, 1204 Jolly Pond Road (Sunday-Saturday: 7 a.m.-5 p.m.)
- James City County's Toano Convenience Center, 187 Industrial Blvd. (Monday, Tuesday, Friday, Saturday: 8a.m.-4p.m.)

HOLIDAY-SEASONAL-TEMPORARY DECORATIONS




Temporary decorations/lighting used for a national, state, local, or religious holiday aka "holiday decorations" may be displayed up to 30 days before and 14 days after the holiday. These may include inflatable decorations. Seasonal decorations (ex: pumpkins for autumn) may not use inflatables, but may be displayed during the seasonal dates.

We should all take our neighbors into consideration when displaying our decorations so as to not infringe on their enjoyment of their property. Decorative lighting that would remain longer than the above limits would require an ARB application, see ARB Standards (part two of our Handbook) for requirements.



NEWPORT NEWS: All leaves must be placed into clear plastic bags to be picked up with Bulk Trash. Please do not place the bags on your curb until 5:00 pm the Sunday evening before bulk trash pick-up. You may also place leaves into your regular trash bin to be picked up on Wednesdays. (Only what will fit in the bin will be picked up on Wednesdays, not any extra bags.) Newport News Bulk Trash Days are Oct. 13 & 27, Nov. 10 & 24 and Dec. 8 & 22

Storm Debris (branches/limbs) is also collected during normal bulk trash times as well.

YORKTOWN: York County does not have a routine bulk trash pick-up service; therefore, they schedule a leaf pick-up every two weeks in the fall. All leaves must be placed into clear plastic bags.

Please DO NOT place leaves on the curb until 5:00 pm Sunday evening of the scheduled pick-up week. The starting date has not been set yet, but typically starts the first full week in November. Please contact Y.C. Solid Waste at 757-890-3780


STORM DEBRIS (branches/limbs) for York County residents can be disposed of in one of the following ways:

- o Placed into your regular trash bin (if it can fit),
- Taken to the Y.C. Dump at 145 Goodwin Neck Rd.,
- o Schedule a pick-up (free 2x per month) at 757-890-3780.

***If you live in a private neighborhood, please contact your management company for proper disposal of leaves.







IF YOU'RE OUT SHOPPING:

- Park in a well-lit area and be sure to locate your keys before going to your car so you're not distracted in the parking lot.
- Always lock your vehicle and keep valuables out of view or in your trunk.
- Stay alert and be aware of your surroundings; avoid being distracted by electronic devices.
- If you carry a wallet, keep it in the front pocket. If it is in a purse, keep purse in front of you.
- If you take your children shopping, teach them to go to a police officer, a store security guard, or a store employee if they get separated or lost.
- Keep an eye out for anything that doesn't look right and don't hesitate to call the police nonemergency number: Newport News (757) 247-2500, York County (757) 890-3621. In an emergency, always dial 9-1-1.

IF YOU'RE TRAVELING:

- Put a holiday hold on mail and newspapers.
- Ask a neighbor to watch your home, shovel snow and park in the driveway from time to time.
- Do not broadcast your vacation plan on social media.
- Get an automatic timer for your indoor and outdoor lights.

IF YOU'RE AT HOME:

- Always keep doors and windows locked.
- Tear down gift boxes before putting them in the recycling and trash; you do not want to advertise what is available in your home.
- Place trees away from heat sources, including fireplaces and heat vents to avoid drying out the tree.
- Always keep a live tree stand filled with water.
- Keep candles or any other open flames at least a foot away from burnable materials. Extinguish candles when you are no longer going to be in that room.
- Never leave open flames or cooking burners unattended.
- Dispose of Christmas trees properly. Dried trees are a fire hazard and should not be left in the home or garage.
- Avoid overloading electrical outlets, which may overheat and start a fire.
- Make sure you've updated your CO2 and smoke alarm batteries and sensors.

IF YOU'RE HAVING PACKAGES DELIVERED:

- Avoid doorstep package theft; consider shipping packages to your place of work or use the ship to store option.
- · Sign up for delivery alerts so you know when your delivery is scheduled and when the package has been delivered.
- If you're not able to be home when a package will be delivered, ask a trusted neighbor to hold it for you.

This includes, but is not limited to, changes to paint colors, removal of architectural features, installation of trash can enclosures, and removal of bushes or trees.

Wandering Pets: The Neighborhood Advisory Committee has received reports of unattended dogs in the community. As stated in the "Villages of Kiln Creek Owners Association Handbook" (revised June 27, 2019, Section II, Rules/Use of Property, Page 9, Paragraph 1.b.), "When outdoors, pets must be leashed and accompanied by a responsible person who can control the pet. Pets may not be left unattended except while in a fenced private yard. Pet owners are responsible for the immediate removal and proper disposal of animal waste."
