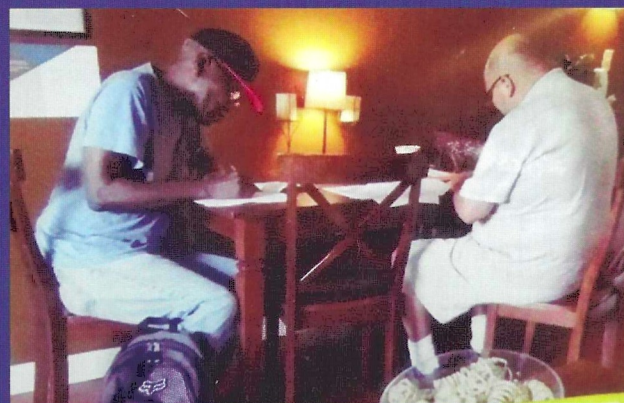


## About us..

LINK's Veterans Emergency Shelter began in 2009 due to the growing number of homeless veterans living on the streets. This program is a partnership with the Veterans Administration Medical Center, which assists LINK in providing holistic programs and services to ensure veteran needs are met during their stay.

LINK provides three meals and two snacks a day, clothing, furniture, shelter, transportation, and case management support during a veteran stay at one of the two homes. LINK offers the opportunity to also shop at LINK's Clothing Closet, engage in community support services, recreational outings, volunteer, wellness sessions at the Veterans Administration Medical Center, weekly house meetings, community BBQ's and assistance with obtaining benefits or employment assistance.

Veterans' goals are supported throughout their stay with us.



Our Veterans Emergency Shelter program provides a safe, comfortable community-based environment promoting stability and reintegration back to independent living. A variety of resources accessing identification and securing employment or federal compensation, medical programs, socialization, and recreational opportunities are offered to all of our veterans during their time in LINK's Veteran homes.

Each house has individual bedrooms, TVs in each bedroom, and ample room to utilize computers, telephone, day courses, and reacclimate to living in a home again. Lastly, during your stay, you will work with a team towards accessing a Veterans Administration housing voucher for your permanent supportive housing unit or permanent housing without a Veteran's Administration subsidy.
