PLEASE STAY OFF THE GOLF COURSE WHILE WALKING

PET REMINDER!

our Kiln Creek Rules.

We ask that you please do not walk, ride or take pets for a walk on the golf course or golf cart paths unless you are playing golf. Walking on the golf course other than for playing golf is both a trespassing and a safety issue. Significant damage can occur, even unintentionally, when walking on sensitive parts of the course that can cause thousands of dollars in repairs.

We have had multiple complaints recently about this being a

problem in Avery Woods and in Southlake specifically. Please contact the HOA office if you know of any owners not following

Section II - Rules/Use of Property - Animals states, "When outdoors, pets must be leashed and accompanied by a responsible person who can control the pet. Pets may not be left unattended except while in a fenced private yard. Pet owners who want to install invisible, underground electric fences to keep their animals inside their Lot must file an application for exterior alteration with the Association's ARB. No pet may be leashed or tethered to any stationary object. Pet owners are responsible for the immediate removal and proper disposal of animal waste."

- REMINDERS -

Most of all we are concerned about the safety of our residents. Any golfer, regardless of skill level hits a few "foul balls" from time to time. These balls can travel for hundreds of yards in any direction. There are also times when certain chemical applications are being applied that would make it temporarily unsafe for people and pets to walk on the turf. Thank you for staying on the pathways for your liesurely walks/rides and NOT the golf course!

- 2. Please do not permit your pets to go onto other neighbor's property without their permission.
- 3. MOST IMPORTANTLY, please ensure while taking your pet on walks off of your own property, that your pet is on a leash and accompanied by a responsible person who can control the pet at all times.







BE VISIBLE WHEN OUTDOORS AT NIGHT

Our days can sometimes start before the morning dawn and end in the darkness of night. Residents may be out early walking, going to work or kids at bus stops. It is sometimes very difficult to see a pedestrian if they are wearing dark colored clothing, and too often that can happen. Please try to be as safe as possible when outdoors at early morning hours and in the evening/nighttime by wearing something that will make you more visible. Reflexive belts, vests and light colored clothing can really help other pedestrians, bicyclists and oncoming traffic see you better.

ABOVE GROUND POOLS TEMPORARILTY ALLOWED!

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

We understand that some residents may still not wish to visit the pool this year for safety reasons, therefore the Board of Directors has also approved a temporary variance for above-ground pools in fenced backyards until September 30, 2023.

The general idea is to allow those of you with children (and those of you who may still be a child a heart!) to get some relaxation, cooling, and recreational relief at home. There are a number of obligations and restrictions to which to take note, and all pools must be removed immediately at the encoder the coarses.

Please note the basic requirements of this SPECIAL ALLOWANCE:

- One above-ground swimming pool may be placed in the backyard only of a residential Lot
- A fence is required for any pools that will not be drained after each use.
- The Lot Owner/resident must comply with all ordinances of York County (for Lots located in York County) and the City of Newport News (for Lots located in the City of Newport News), including but not limited to any fencing requirements.
- If a fence is to be constructed, a prior application for the fence must be submitted to the Association's Architectural Review Board ("ARB") and approved by the ARB, and the fence must conform to the ARB's specifications and requirements for fences in the Villages of Kiln Creek.
- The above-ground pool must be fully and completely removed from the Lot on or before September 30, 2023.
- Owners shall be responsible for re-seeding during the fall of 2023, any portions of their lawn that have been damaged as a result of the pool.
- The pool shall be installed at least 5 feet from the property line/fence."

ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW BOARD

SHEDS & ACCESSORY STRUCTURES

BY: JIM PADDLEFORD, BOD TREASURER AND CHAIRMAN OF ARB

Sheds or other storage structures require an ARB application for approval prior to purchasing or building. This should include detailed plans of the lot placement, specifications-including dimensions and square feet of a structure (maximum of 150 Square feet and no more than 10 feet above ground level). and materials to be used. A sketch of the structure along with site plans (plot of property) must be included. The shed should be proportional to the lot and house size. Sheds should be permanent structures and comprised of quality materials that will last a long time. The roof and siding must match the house as best as possible and may not be constructed of metal or plywood on the exterior surface. The siding may be of Resin construction provided that it has a wooden or metal frame to make it sturdy.

Sheds on properties with brick homes may be constructed with siding made from composite shingles (hardiboard), wood shingles, or horizontal vinyl siding. Roofs on stick-built sheds must have the same style and color shingles as the house and if the house shingle's color is changed, the shed must be changed also.

Only one shed per lot is allowed and it must be securely fastened to the ground/Concrete slab to prevent being blown over by high winds. It must be located at least five feet from the property line and behind the rear foundation line and have minimal impact on the site lines of neighboring properties. Electrical service to the shed must have a permit and amperage included in plans submitted to ARB.

Smaller Rubbermaid style sheds also require an ARB application and must be made of heavy-duty, quality materials with a maximum height of 60 inches and be no more than 25 Square feet in floor area. They must be a neutral color and unpainted. They must also be behind the rear foundation line and adjacent to the house as on a patio or deck. If the structure becomes worn, faded, weathered, or in disrepair, maintenance rules shall apply. Deck boxes less than 15 Square feet do not need an application.





RULES & STANDARDS UPDATES COMMITTEE
